APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Deadline	Fall semester or entire academic year at Icam : June 30th Spring semester : October 30th
Application procedures for incoming students	The standing procedure to be followed is that the home university first nominates the students by email to Icam Erasmus coordinator : catherine.maury@icam.fr Including : Student's full name and e-mail Field of studies at the home university Level of studies (Bachelor/ Master) Period of exchange : Fall/Winter Semester - Spring/Summer Semester Semester – Full year Type of exchange program : classes-scientific project-Double Degree Then, the International Relations Office at Icam of the campus selected by the students, sends the application documents to the students.
Requested documentation	1. Application form printed and signed by the applicant with the stamp and signature of the partner university

(sent by email)	<p>2. Copy of your passport for non-European students</p> <p>3. Copy of your Passport or European ID Card for European students</p> <p>4. One ID Picture MANDATORY in JPEG format</p> <p>5. Letter of enrolment of the sending university</p> <p>6. <u>For European students</u>: copy of the European Health Insurance student card</p> <p>7. Official transcript</p>
VISA Requirement	All applicants from Non European countries need a visa to study in France. In order to get it, the students can contact Campus France or apply at the embassy or consulate of France in their home country.

ACADEMIC INFORMATION

Semester dates	<p>For Year B3 : from September to end of January and from February to the beginning of June</p> <p>For Year M1 : from the end of September to the end of January and from the beginning of February to the beginning of July</p> <p>For Year M2 : from the beginning of September to mid February and from the beginning of February to the beginning of July</p>
Orientation Week	First week of September or First week of February [Information, French courses...]
Study plans	Exchange students can choose different itineraries (B3, M1 or M2 semester/year). They can check the syllabus of each one on our website.
Transcripts of Records	One copy of the transcript of records will be sent directly to the home institution and to the student by email.
Language Requirements	<p>Classes are taught in French. Some of them are taught in English.</p> <p>For Year M1 the first semester is entirely taught in English at Toulouse campus. The applicant should have a sufficient level in French or English to follow classes without any difficulty.</p> <p>English : B2 level certificate or equivalent</p> <p>French : A2+ level Certificate or equivalent</p>
Grades	The grading system at Icam is the European grading system.
Exams and evaluations	Depending on the course, the type of exams or points of evaluation may differ. Written exams, oral exams, multiple choice questions, essay and group projects are common ways for a teacher to evaluate the students.
French language courses	Exchange students have access to French language courses without any extra charge. The courses are put in their schedule.
Bachelor Project and Master Thesis	<p>Icam teaching process is very much on project based activities which can take place either at Bachelor or Master level. Each thesis will be done under the supervision of an experienced project manager.</p> <p>This option offers the exchange students the possibility of working with firms under industrial contracts or to contribute to research activities undergoing at Icam labs. The thesis can be conducted along with courses, or as the core academic activity of the semester. Project based activities will be mostly done in English (B2 level required). Basic level of French is mandatory (A2) to handle the normal day to day life in France.</p>

STUDENT LIFE INFORMATION

Accommodation	Each Icam campus has its own students' residence. Once the application accepted, the person in charge of the residence will send to the exchange student the documents to apply for a room.

Requirements	<p>Your health insurance has to cover (all) :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Medical, surgical, pharmaceutical hospitalization and ambulances expenses ● repatriation or medical transport in case of illness or injury ● Assistance services (medical evacuation and repatriation to home country) ● Personal liability (coverage of damage caused to third party, housing included) ● Work accident (for internship)
